Porters Racing - year in review

The first full season for the Porters Pro Stock Mustang competing in the 2007/08 Australian National Drag Racing Series has just concluded at the Castrol Edge Winternationals at Willowbank Raceway. The series commenced in September 2007 at Western Sydney International Dragway with a further 5 rounds held at both Ipswich and Sydney.

Throughout the series, 20 cars contested this very competitive ANDRA Group 1 bracket with the Porters Mustang finishing fourth in Australia in the overall points chase. For every meeting, only the fastest 8 cars qualify to go into the elimination rounds on race day with the Porters Mustang accomplishing this achievement at every event.

Team Owner Paul Porter said "Scott and the crew have a good handle on the driving and the tuning of the car and have perfected their various roles over the past 12 months. The best performance from the Mustang was at the Summernationals in Sydney running an elapsed time of 7.153 seconds at 190 Miles Per Hours (306 KPH). This currently stands as the fastest Ford-powered Pro Stock quarter-mile pass in Australia. The crew has put in an enormous effort over the season and I thank them for their contribution to the racing team."

The current season commences in September 2008 with the first round hosted by Western Sydney International Dragway. The crew has been spending their time overhauling the Mustang and fitting out the new transporter, complete with workshop and corporate facility. The team is looking at improvements throughout the whole operation as the 2008/09 racing series is expected to be even more competitive with a further 5 to 6 more racers expected to enter the pro stock ranks.

The success of the Mustang can not only be attributed to the outstanding features of the vehicle, but also the dedication and passion of the whole Porters Racing team and sponsors.
